PathName: Name of the Right of Way consisting of the Parish Name and a Number.

Pathstatus: Type of Right of Way. Possible Values: Footpath, Bridleway, Byway Open to All Traffic, Restricted Byway, Temp Closed Footpath, Temp Footpath, Unmetalled UCR (See also Note 1).

Parish: Name of the Parish within the Definitive Statement containing the written descriptions of the Right of Way.

Comments: Generally relating to the duration of Temporary Rights of Way and closures.

District: Name of the District within which the Right of Way exists.

Valchar: Abbreviation of the type of Right of Way. Possible Values: FP, BR, BOAT, RB, TCFP, TFP, UUCR (See also Note 1).

Unitid: Unique ID derived from Parishid and Pathnumb used within the Highways Management system.

Parishid: ID denoting Parish.

Pathnumb: Path Number (may include a suffix letter).

Rwattrkey: Unique ID used within the HERMIS system.

URL: Hyperlink to the Definitive Statement

PTROType: Permanent Traffic Regulation Order Type.

PTROYear: The year that the Permanent Traffic Regulation Order was enacted.

PTROURL: Hyperlink to the HertsDirect page for the Permanent Traffic Regulation Order links.

USRN: Unique Street Reference Number.

CONF_VC: Status of path as recorded in the Highways Confirm Database.

SURVEY: Year when path was last checked/surveyed for Ease of Use (using BVPI178 criteria).

BVPI: Shows whether the right of way passed or failed the Ease of Use Survey.
